

Associate Degrees Awarded

Definition: The number of students that earned a degree within a specific academic year. The cohort analysis includes all non-special admit students that began in the 2018-2019 academic year and earned an associate degree in four years. More information about degree earners are available in this OIE memo.

Analysis: The enrollment declines of 2020 and 2021 are having an impact on completions as the 2023-2024 year came just above the College's minimum/set standard. In addition, an <u>analysis</u> by the California Community College Chancellor's Office shows that Black/African American and Latina/o/x students are completing degrees at lower rates than many of their peers.
